

Election Directions for all Nominees

1. Print off the nomination form for the position you are running for
2. Fill in the nomination form and request nominations from individuals who are members of the constituent group you want to represent (e.g. COTR students)
3. Write a brief one to two paragraph biography telling people who you are and why you are running for the seat. Email this biography along with a current picture to the College of the Rockies (COTR) Chief Electoral Officer, Jason Colombo, at jcolombo@cotr.bc.ca by 4:00 pm on September 18, 2018.
4. Submit the completed nomination form to the College Chief Electoral Officer, Jason Colombo, by 4:00 pm on September 18, 2018. Jason is located in the Student Services Department in the Kootenay Centre Building (front entrance) on the Cranbrook Campus. Nominees from Regional Campuses or online nominees can fax their nomination forms to 250-489-8218 attention Jason Colombo, scan their nomination form and submit to jcolombo@cotr.bc.ca or use the interoffice mail system available at the Regional Campus closest to them. College of the Rockies has Regional Campuses in Creston, Fernie, Golden, Kimberley and Invermere.
5. Campaign between September 20, 2018 and October 1, 2018. Campaigning is at the individual's expense and on his/her own time. Campaigning includes, but is not limited to, posters, signs, websites, social media, and telephone/email campaigns. All campaign material must be removed from College notice boards and social media etc. before the election period (October 2-4, 2018).
